Dear Sister / Brother in Christ,

This packet is designed to give you a clear understanding of the nature of Caroline Furnace Lutheran Camp and what we are looking for in staff members. Prayerfully consider all aspects of this commitment as you decide to apply.

Our mission in our Summer Camp Program is to provide “an intentional Christian communal experience in the midst of God’s creation.” This begins with an unconditional commitment to love, accept and respect each camper as a child of God. We strive to recognize and develop each camper’s unique gifts and abilities; embrace and proclaim a Christian lifestyle on and off the camp, and demonstrate sound environmental stewardship in all aspects of daily life. We believe campers who are loved and accepted in the midst of a caring Christian community are likely to experience the Holy Spirit at work in them.

A summer in outdoor ministry is long, tiring, sometimes difficult, and one of the most rewarding summers you will likely ever have. We expect a commitment to our campers, a forgiving spirit, and hard work. During your stay with us, you will grow in many ways. Living and working in close quarters with other staff members will give you an unforgettable experience of Christian community by teaching you how to work closely with others in a loving relationship, by supporting your uniqueness and by testing your patience. Spending most of your time outdoors will give you an appreciation for the beauty of God’s creation, and a respect for manmade creations such as bug spray and sunscreen. Those called to serve on our summer staff will learn much from other members of the staff, from campers and most importantly from God.

Included in this packet, you will find a job description and qualifications page, a Summer Camp Staff Application, three copies of the reference form and a frequently asked questions page. Complete the application and mail it to me in the envelope provided. When your application is received you will be notified by email. Please distribute the three reference forms and have those mailed directly to me. When I have received the application and all three references I will review it and be in touch with you and if need be to schedule an interview. Upon completion of the interview you may be offered a position. I suggest you consult with your pastor, family, former staff members, and friends for their guidance about this opportunity. Responsible to: Summer Program Director and Executive Director

Responsibilities:

1. To be a model of Christian living, actively pursuing a growing relationship with Jesus the Christ as Lord
2. To know where your campers are at all times
3. Live with and provide 24-hour care for up to eight campers per week, guiding and directing them in camp activities. Some weeks your assignment will be out-trips and/or day trips off the grounds
4. To provide support to other members of the staff
5. To lead daily Bible studies related to the summer curriculum
6. Assist in interpreting health and safety regulations to campers, including care of living quarters, site, personal habits, and God's creation
7. Participate in ten days of staff training beginning June 6, 2010
8. Assist in worship activities as assigned
9. Carry out the directives of the Directors as assigned

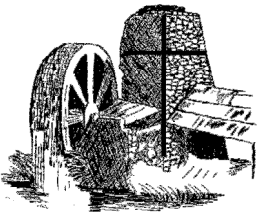

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What will I get paid?

Summer staff with us for the first time will receive \$195.00 a week. Staff members are paid for the 10-day training period and all weeks worked.

When will I have days off?

Your workweek begins on Sundays at 2:00 with a staff meeting and ends on Friday after the staff meeting. You will have Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday morning off. On Sunday we encourage you to worship in the congregation of your choice.

What if I don't mountain bike? That's okay, we try to assign each counselor to a variety of different camp experiences, but we also take into account each individual's particular skills and abilities.

Can I commit to a wedding or family vacation during the summer?

Caroline Furnace can usually grant up to a week of time off for a special request, but in some cases it is just not possible. Please make your special request known at the time of application or during your interview. The Executive Director will determine if your request can be granted.

What are the living conditions like?

All summer staff will be housed in cabins, sukkahs or tents. The cabins have one large room with bunk beds and a small bathroom with toilet and sink. Sleeping up to 14 they are complete with running water and electricity. The Sukkahs are small screened in units with a roof each sleeping a counselor and up to 7 campers with no utilities.

How much money will I need?

Lodging and meals are provided for you by Caroline Furnace for the summer. You will only need money for outings on weekends (i.e.: food, Wal-Mart, entertainment, ice cream, etc.)

What do I need to bring?

All summer staff members are expected to provide their own personal items, sleeping bag and/or bedding, clothing, and a good pair of hiking boots or tennis shoes. Other strongly encouraged items are a backpack, flashlight, necessary rain gear, fleece or light weight jacket for cool nights, water bottles, and good socks. All equipment necessary for the camp programs will be provided by Caroline Furnace.

What about Laundry? We have several sets of washers and dryers for your use at no charge.

Can I bring my own vehicle?

Yes. There is parking available for personal vehicles for use on the weekends. During the regular camp sessions, however, you will be unable to use your vehicle. Caroline Furnace will provide transportation for all activities related to the summer camp schedule.

What about dating relationships?

Romantic relationships between a Caroline Furnace staff member and camper are **strictly prohibited**. Our focus is on the ministry we offer so dating relationships among members of the staff are discouraged. Such relationships may distract individuals and disrupt the community at Caroline Furnace. In such a close community, however, we realize that feelings for others are bound to occur. In such cases, we observe a **“no touch rule”** while there are campers in residence. We ask that the relationship remain unknown to campers and do everything necessary to preserve the community and atmosphere of Caroline Furnace. Problems and conflicts in these areas will be handled by the Executive Director.
